










Dr Hayo Reinders is Editor of Innovation in Language Learning and Teaching. A frequent keynote speaker at international events, he was previously founding Director of the English Language Self-Access Centre at the University of Auckland and Visiting Professor at Meiji University in Japan. He is currently Director of Language and Learner Support at Middlesex University in the UK. His most recent projects include books on teaching methodologies, Transform your Teaching: Strategies for Multicultural Education., published by Pearson Education, and an edited book on Learner and Teacher Autonomy, published by Benjamins. His interests are in Teacher Education, CALL, and Learner Autonomy.

Professor Insung Jung is currently serving on the faculty of the International Christian University (ICU) in Tokyo. Before joining ICU as a full professor of the Division of Education in 2003, she served as the Director of the Multimedia Education Center at the Ewha Women's University in Seoul. The Center was established to develop, deliver and manage e-learning programs for the University, and Dr Jung established numerous collaborative relationships with national, regional and international institutions to deliver courses and degree programs to professional women in the region and throughout the world.
